New Read & Publish Agreement with Wiley Entitles Authors to Publish Open Access Free of Charge

Scientists of Eawag, Empa, PSI & WSL can now publish Open Access articles free of charge in most of Wiley's subscription journals. The option to publish Open Access applies to all research and review articles accepted for publication on or after 1 May 2021. The prerequisite for this is an affiliation of the corresponding author with Eawag, Empa, PSI or WSL. [Read more](#).

China / Warning List of International Journals

The Chinese Academy of Sciences issued the first warning list of international journals, disproportionately targeting full-OA journals that attract a high volume of Chinese content. Clarivate's acquisition of ProQuest is the largest transaction in recent memory in the scholarly information sector. Both companies work extensively as intermediaries with publishers and libraries.
